## Sexual Misconduct/Sexual Assault

- ▶ Non-consensual sexual contact, non-consensual sexual intercourse or sexual exploitation.

## Sexual Harassment

- ▶ Unwelcome sexual advances.
- ▶ Request for sexual favors.
- ▶ Verbal or physical harassment of a sexual nature.

## Stalking

- ▶ Engaging in a course of conduct directed at a specific person that would cause that person to feel fear for his or her safety or the safety of others (i.e. following, monitoring).

## Dating/Domestic Violence

- ▶ Crime of violence committed by a current or former intimate partner.



# Your Rights

- ▶ Investigation
  - ▶ Reporting to responsible employees
- ▶ File a police report (or not)
- ▶ Interim measures
- ▶ Counseling and other support services
- ▶ Participate in proceedings with an adviser

# How to respond

- ▶ Indirect or direct
- ▶ Tell someone
- ▶ Use group pressure
- ▶ Distract
- ▶ Ask the victim if they are okay
- ▶ Ask if they want to leave
- ▶ Call the police
- ▶ Bias Response Team

# Emergency Management

## **EVACUATE** when building alarms sound

- ▶ Leave the building immediately.
- ▶ Don't use elevators, assist the disabled.

## **LOCKDOWN** when given the order

- ▶ Stay in your room or building.
- ▶ Lock or barricade doors, close blinds, turn off light.

## **SEEK SHELTER** when outdoor warning sounds

- ▶ Find a safe room away from doors/windows.
- ▶ Listen for instruction from the indoor warning system.
